



The enterprise **Computer Zentrum Strausberg GmbH** was founded in 1992. Since then the company develops electronic data processing systems for public administration organs throughout Germany.

In 2002 the Computer Zentrum Strausberg GmbH started to design multilingual Internet applications. The entry of Poland into the European Union initiated the development of a Polish-German Online Dictionary. This dictionary became the base for the multilingual Internet platform www.xlingua.de. Today the *xLingua* online dictionary is being used by many German and Polish speakers. In 2009 English has been added to the *xLingua* platform. The same year we introduced our first implementation of an African language. On the **eLearning Conference 2009** in Dakar we constated wide interest for our Wolof-German Dictionary.

The conference **eLearning Africa 2011** now takes place in Dar es Salaam. This inspired us to use the *xLingua* technology to develop new Dictionaries both for Swahili and Igbo. This way we intend to show our respect for Swahili and Igbo as widely used African languages in Eastern as well as Western Africa.

Furthermore we would like to give our credits to Tanzania as the host of this year's **eLearning Africa** conference.
